Another goal this year will be to publicly highlight the outstanding work of our committees and task forces. Expect to see communications from EAST to ensure our members know about all these great offerings to enhance and drive our mission.

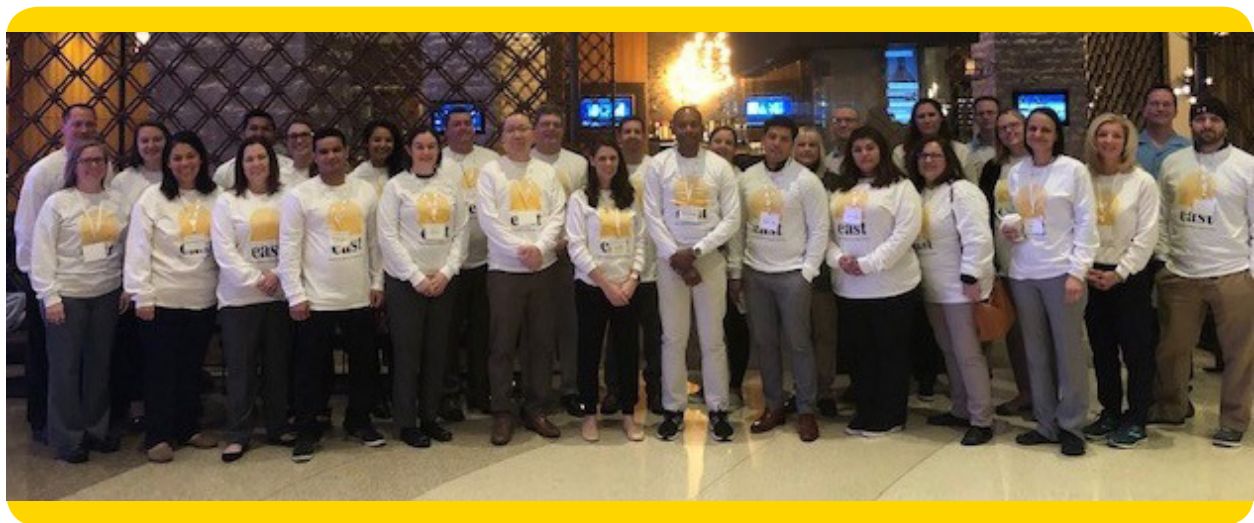
Each year sessions cover challenging topics and a chance for many to show their work.

Development Fund

Hello, fellow Eastern Association for the Surgery of Trauma (EAST) members, and welcome to our new members, in particular. I want to reach out to you in my role as the Chair of the EAST Development Committee. We had a banner year by all measures in 2018, and I certainly hope that we can work together to repeat our accomplishments, if not surpass them, in 2019. For our new members, the Development Committee oversees the EAST Development Fund, which is supported mainly by our membership. These are just some of the scholarships and programs your donations help EAST fund:

- The EAST Trauma Research Scholarship: \$40,000 per year
- The EAST INVEST-C Research Hackathon: \$20,000 per year
- GRADE Training: \$10,000 per year
- The EAST Multicenter Junior Investigator Award: \$6,000 per year

As you can see, the total money that we spend each year on member benefits – particularly early career member benefits – is significant. In 2018, we

raised almost \$127,000! This is simply incredible and has set a new bar for us. The EAST Development Fund has a value of \$1.1 million dollars – another milestone achievement. The goal is for the value of the Fund to be \$1.5 million and have the earnings support all of the above activities. Achieving that goal will enable EAST to start new initiatives in support of furnishing leadership and fostering advances in the surgery of trauma. Speaking of milestones, thank you to our **Milestone Donors**. Past President Kimberly Davis, MD, MBA has really set the example here – thank you, Dr. Davis. I encourage all of our members to contribute to the Development Fund and be appropriately recognized by EAST for doing so. Log in to your **membership profile** to review your giving status and consider reaching a new milestone by donating. I strongly encourage a regular contribution at a lower dollar figure over a larger contribution.

In January, we raised over \$19,000 in individual contributions – yet another new record – with the majority of our supporters donating at



the EAST Annual Scientific Assembly. Thank you! We also appreciate the ongoing support of the Polk Family Foundation and the Dorothy K. Commanday Foundation whose generous contributions continue to support our education and leadership initiatives. Remember that you too can designate how your donations will be used: trauma research, injury control and violence prevention, or education and leadership development. You can also choose to donate to the General Development Fund.

Beginning last year, the Development Committee also started looking into aligning with our industry partners through an initiative called the EAST Think Group. This is a partnership which allows industry to meet with a select group of EAST members who are trauma

leaders for up to two hours in order to determine how they can further the management and treatment of injured and critically ill patients. This partnership benefits industry, EAST, and most importantly, our patients. In its first year, this initiative allowed us to raise \$30,000 – 25% of the total money we collected in 2018. Thank you sincerely to the EAST members who donated their time to this initiative – this achievement is yours. We plan to double this program in 2019 and early 2020. Thank you in advance to members who will be asked to donate their time in 2019.

Lastly, the Development Committee is working closely with the EAST Board of Directors to determine how we can replace the traditional Dodgeball Tournament with an activity that is safe, fun, and allows us to contribute to the Development Fund in a way that will payback our members in the long run. I am open to any ideas the members have and welcome emails from you on this topic.

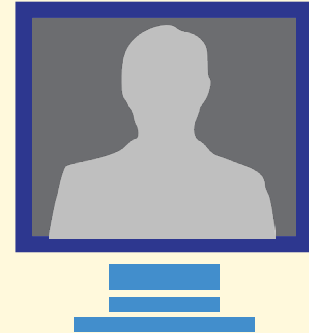
